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Duties & responsibilities

For all roles

- Understand and implement all Safeguarding policies and procedures in relation to working with children and young people

- Undertake other duties as appropriate to the level of the role as required

Duties & responsibilities

- 1. Safely transport pupils to and from offsite educational visits, school events, sports fixtures, and other activities as needed, ensuring they board and disembark safely
- 2. Keep the minibus clean and tidy, both inside and out
- 3. Maintain high standards of ethics and behaviour, demonstrating positive attitudes and values

- 4. Conduct thorough pre-trip and post-trip inspections to ensure the vehicle is safe and roadworthy
- 5. Report any defects following Trust procedures
- 6. Enforce safety rules and regulations for pupils during transit
- 7. Be prepared to handle emergencies and provide first aid if necessary
- 8. Communicate effectively with schools regarding pick-up and drop-off times and any changes to the schedule
- 9. Maintain accurate records of trips, including mileage, fuel consumption, and any incidents
- 10. Participate in relevant training courses
- 11. Adhere to all traffic regulations
- 12. Actively support the Trust's sustainability mission by promoting eco-friendly practices, such as reducing idling time and optimising routes to minimize fuel consumption
