To be more organised before my child returns back to school after breaks ie booking in for after school clubs etc The behaviour by certain children in Oke Tor isn't always good. This has definitely had a negative impact on our youngest son. He finds it difficult to concentrate at times, but hopefully, things will improve with Mr Jayne being the class teacher full time. I do worry about my child - he gets upset about returning to school, after the half term breaks and school holidays and this is not something we used to experience when he was returning to his old school. I do know that he is happy at Lew Trenchard and Ms Davy has worked with me and my child to make his transition easier. Extra activities (after school) for Year 1. believe my children are working a great depth but I still don't really know what this means. Also as a parent I would like to help more. Meant to say on the last reply that my daughter tells me she gets bored!! My son doesn't say he get's bored but I am not sure academically if he is being stretched, - math homework takes him all of minutes (mistakes made due to rushing which we discuss) understand this is a fine line. Not had a school report yet so again marked a box. More staff to help support children on a one 2 one basis We would love to see Mrs Davy on the gates in the mornings more as I know the children and parents appreciate this personal touch. It would be great to have more visibility of class teachers at the school gate. I know that they are available on dojo, but we rarely see them in person. A minor issue with dojo is that sometimes it is difficult to search for previous posts and information can be lost or overlooked due to it having dropped down the page. It would also be helpful to be able to search for posts or classrooms. Perhaps this is something that could be fed back to dojo. Honestly struggling to answer this question. I'd like to see more investment from MAT trust, or least transparency as to what they have invested in our school in particular.
