

Thank you for these comments. We have made some changes and will continue to develop the school further using your responses from the survey.

## Areas for improvement

'More activities': We have worked hard this term to increase the amount of enrichments provided this term to support the curriculum and the provision planned within school time. Teachers have planned and refined their rolling programmes to include topics which are interesting and appealing to the pupils. Pupils have also been receiving/will receive weekly sessions of High 5 Sport (includes a range of sports), half termly sessions of Wild Tribe (outdoor learning) and 12 sessions of swimming for Buzzards' Class. Both classes have also taken part in local visits this half term. After school clubs include Art and Wild Tribe. The school also hosts a Moor Film Club fortnightly which is run by Med Theatre group. We will continue to build on this area during the course of the year to include opportunities for competitive sport, trips that link to the pupils' learning and another after school club.

'More communication': Currently we strive to regularly communicate to parents via letters, newsletters, website and verbal communication via Teachers/Head of School on the playground in the mornings or after school. We hope to build on this communication via social media (setting up a Twitter page).

Homework: We have ensured that all pupils are receiving homework this term. All pupils are encouraged to read daily, practise their spellings/phonics and times tables (in Years 2-6). Buzzards' Class also receive a half-termly homework menu where they can choose activities related to their current topic to complete.

Website: Mrs Bassett has been working on updating the website this half term. The website now includes updated class pages, staff lists and contacts, newsletters, provisional KS2 results, history of the school and relevant policies. This will continue to built on to include more policies, updated Governor information and information related to special educational needs.
